

Speaking on

"God's Created Dinosaurs"



People of all ages are interested in dinosaurs! Thousands of general interest dinosaur books have been written; most of them

from the perspective of evolution and millions of years. Because many children are very interested in dinosaurs, they can be greatly influenced toward a particular worldview by not only the books, but the many movies and TV shows about dinosaurs. Adults can also be influenced in a similar manner.

At the December 13 First Baptist Church Men's Breakfast, speaker **J.D. Mitchell** will present the biblical creationist view that dinosaurs were created by God on day six of the creation along with mankind and were buried in large numbers in the cataclysmic worldwide Genesis Flood. Some dinosaurs went onto the Ark with Noah and the other animals and were fairly commonly seen by humans for hundreds of years after the time of Christ before they mostly went extinct.

Mr. Mitchell's PowerPoint talk, "<u>God's Created Dinosaurs</u>," will be based in large part on his new dinosaur book, *Guidebook to North American Dinosaurs According to Created Kinds*. This book is the first to attempt to categorize dinosaurs according to their created kinds.

<u>J.D. Mitchell</u> is a registered professional engineer in Oregon and Washington and has a Bachelor of Science in Mechanical Engineering from the University of Washington. He has also completed his Master of Biblical Studies in Biblical Creation Apologetics from Master's Graduate School of Divinity. J.D. is Executive Director of the <u>Institute for Creation Science</u> of Oregon, and speaks and writes regarding the creation versus evolution controversy as a part of his Creation Science research ministry (<u>Creation Engineering Concepts</u>).
