Summer Creation Science Field Trips in June, July & August 2015 Sponsored by Creation Association of Puget Sound

You and your family are invited to the free field trips that will illustrate that the face of the earth can be dramatically changed in a few minutes or hours. It doesn't take millions of years! We will visit the two outstanding examples of these events in our own back yard.

Mt. St. Helens --- Saturday June 13, July 18, August 15

Mt. St. Helens is the site of the largest landslide in recorded history. Paul will start off with a presentation at the Mt St Helens Creation Information Center that again defies the millions of years paradigm. Paul Taylor and Ron Payne will lead a tour that includes the Weyerhaeuser Forest Learning Center, the Hummocks (an easy 2 ¼ mile hike), and Johnston Ridge.







Dry Falls/Scablands --- Saturday June 27 and July 11

For many years geologists thought that the channeled scablands and dry falls of Eastern Washington were carved out by gradual processes over many thousands of years. Now it has been established that they were caused by a massive flood event. Geologist Dennis Bokovoy of Creation Encounters will lead the first trip and show how the devastating Lake Missoula Flood quickly altered the landscape. Ron Payne will lead the second trip. Participants will caravan in their own cars. The trip is limited to 15 vehicles, so carpooling is encouraged.





There is no cost for these trips, although there is an admission fee for the Visitor Center at Johnston Ridge (\$8), and donations will be accepted to help defray costs.
