Dr. Don DeYoung, President of <u>Creation Research Society</u>, will be in town for the <u>Seattle Creation Conference 2016</u> on Friday evening, October 14 and all day Saturday, October 15. The <u>Apologetics Forum</u> is scheduling him for a number of other speaking engagements. This is your opportunity to hear him speak on a number of creation topics of importance to believers and skeptics. Dr. DeYoung has a most impressive career and biography in biblical creation research, as an author, teacher and speaker.

Dr. Don DeYoung is on the science faculty at Grace College, Winona Lake, Indiana. He is a graduate of Michigan Tech University (B.S., M.S., Physics), Iowa State University (Ph.D., Physics), and Grace Theological Seminary (M. Div.). He has written twenty books on Bible-science topics including object lessons for children. His website is DiscoveryofDesign.com.

Don currently is president of the Creation Research Society with 1700 members worldwide. He and his wife Sally have three married daughters. In their local church Don is an overseer and small group leader.
