

High School Debunking Evolution Course

This short course on <u>Debunking Evolution</u> is about 3 hours long. Speaker Pat Roy Bio: Pat Roy worked at the <u>Institute for Creation Research</u> (<u>ICR</u>) for over 12 years. In that time, he and his team conducted hundreds of interviews with leading creation scientists. It was his job to understand the scientific research and to present it to lay-audiences. Pat first begun speaking for <u>ICR</u> over 20 years ago. Later, Pat and his wife, Sandy, created, wrote, and produced the <u>Jonathan Park audio adventures</u>, reaching an audience of millions. Now they have created a new creation-based family audio series called <u>Time Chroniclers</u>. Pat has given hundreds of presentations and hands-on workshops. Pat now serves on the board of the <u>International Association for Creation</u> and Director of <u>Genesis Apologetics</u>. His duties include research, speaking, and producing new resources to reach teens with the scientific case against evolution, and for creation. He and his wife wrote the scripts, and directed the video production of the new <u>Debunking Evolution</u> series.
