



Home School Hands-On Workshop

This **Hands-on workshop** is designed for home school groups (students ages 7 – 18 year olds) and is about 3 hours long. It can be given in a classroom setting during the week (Dec. 7-9) or at a gathering of home school students on Saturday, December 10. The workshop can be tailored in time (1 to 3 hours) and in content to the needs of each home school group.

Speaker Pat Roy Bio: Pat Roy worked at the Institute for Creation Research (ICR) for over 12 years. In that time, he and his team conducted hundreds of interviews with leading creation scientists. It was his job to understand the scientific research and to present it to lay-audiences. Pat first began speaking for ICR over 20 years ago. Later, Pat and his wife, Sandy, created, wrote, and produced the Jonathan Park audio adventures, reaching an audience of millions. Now they have created a new creation-based family audio series called Time Chroniclers. Pat has given hundreds of presentations and hands-on workshops. Pat now serves on the board of the International Association for Creation and Director of Genesis Apologetics. His duties include research, speaking, and producing new resources to reach teens with the scientific case against evolution, and for creation. He and his wife wrote the scripts, and directed the video production of the new Debunking Evolution series.
