

In 2005, Patrick created <u>Northwest</u> <u>Treasures</u> to provide opportunities to study geology from a Biblical perspective. In the fall of 2012, he opened the <u>Geology Learning Center</u>, a geology museum/educational center located in Lynnwood, WA. Patrick leads field trips each year to many geological sites including his annual field trip to Yellowstone Park in August.
